

Exelon Patches

Apply the patch to the upper or lower back, upper arm, or chest. Use a new application site with each new patch. Do not use the same site within 14 days. Document placement of patch site in the MAR.

Some medicines may interact with the Exelon patch. Tell your health care provider if you are taking any other medications, especially any of the following:

- Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs – i.e. ibuprofen): the risk of stomach or bowel bleeding may be increased
- Cholinergic agents (i.e. bethanechol) or another cholinesterase inhibitor (i.e. donepezil): may increase the risk of the Exelon patch's side effects
- Anticholinergics (i.e. scopolamine): effectiveness may be decreased by the Exelon patch.
